The Director will report to the Executive Director of AL Intel and collaborate closely with the Innovation pillar to connect relocating startups to statewide resources, partnerships, and opportunities. This role is instrumental in building a thriving entrepreneurial ecosystem, driving economic growth, and supporting workforce development across Alabama. This position offers a competitive salary between \$100,000 and \$120,000 per year, depending on experience

- **Ecosystem Integration**: Work closely with EDPA's Innovation pillar to connect startups with key resources, including funding opportunities, mentorship programs, workforce pipelines, and partnerships with local businesses and universities.
- **Stakeholder Engagement**: Collaborate with statewide partners, public-private coalitions, and community leaders to align efforts and amplify the impact of technology company attraction initiatives.

 - Exceptional communication and relationship-building skills.

- Ability to think strategically and execute effectively in a dynamic and fast-paced environment. Though this role will report to the Executive Director of AL Intel and work closely with the VP of Innovation, it will have a great degree of independence on a day-to-day basis.
- Collaborative mindset with experience working across diverse teams and sectors. The EDPA is a small nonprofit. We are all team players who step up to tasks outside of our job descriptions when needed.
- Familiarity with Alabama's economic development landscape and strategic industry sectors is a plus.
- Demonstrated ability to manage complex projects and achieve measurable outcomes.
- Willingness to travel and work the occasional night or weekend, as this role will require networking at events outside of business hours.
